The seminar is organized by the Abruzzo Region in collaboration with the University of Teramo within the Adrigov Project funded under the IPA Adriatic CBC Programme. The project AdriGov aims to capitalize on the existing cooperation networks and the various initiatives taken in the Adriatic Ionian Initiative, constituting a valid operational support to the political process of institutional cooperation carried out as part of the 'Adriatic Euroregion (EAI) is a valuable contribution to the definition of the European Union Strategy for the Adriatic-Ionian macro-region (EUSAIR).

The seminar aims to examine the challenges posed by the creation of the European Macro Region for future projects.

For some time, in fact, they preached the need for organizational improvement in the management of structural funds by concentrating on well-specified results, the simplification of the instruments of governance and procedures, coordination between a number of proposed interventions. In the 2014-2020 programming period are the basis for a re-orientation of the overall European policy as the new regulatory texts, in the face of organizational rigidity of individual government departments found until the recent past, contain important cues to encourage the recruitment of macro-regional dimension as a new paradigm territorial reference design, suitable to ensure flexibility and efficiency to the actions of individual programs.

The aim of the seminar is, therefore, to map out the evolutionary lines of the macro-regional dimension in order to verify the possibility of re-orienting methodologically operational programs of the 2014-2020 cycle of this new territorial focus as a solution to the critical issues of the past experiences of European programming. Therefore moving from discussion of the constitutive features of the Adriatic Ionian Macro Region and its governance, the analysis will focus on the connections of the main European programs and the potential of the new territorial dimension.
