Finding us by public transports

The Brussels Transport Authority (<u>STIB/MIVB</u>) is the main public transport operator in Brussels. Its trams, buses and underground trains form an integrated network, so you can easily transfer from one mode to another using the same ticket.

Underground stops close to the Euroregion Office and to the main EU Institutions:

- Maelbeek (2-minute walk to the Office)
- Schuman (10-minute walk to the Office)
- Trône (15 minute-walk to the Office).


The most convenient Metro Station is Maelbeek Station. At the exit, turn right, follow Chaussee de Etterbeek until you get to Rue Jaque de Lalaing. Cross the street and go left to Rue de Toulouse until you reach the number 47.
