The Adriatic-Ionian Euroregion (AIE) is an international association established on June 30, 2006, in Pula (Croatia), with the goal of promoting transnational and interregional cooperation between regions and local authorities of the Adriatic and Ionian basin.

The association brings together 33 members - Regional and Local authorities from Italy, Croatia, Greece, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro and Albania. The total area covered by these is approximately 200.000 square kilometers, with an estimated population of around 20 million inhabitants.

The AIE is a model for cross-border and interregional co-operation aimed to promote the coordinated and integrated development between regions of the area. Since 2006, the AIE has targeted its efforts towards ensuring the interests of its members and towards the common development of the whole area. The association supports the members - especially those in the European accession process - in creating joint initiatives and preparing regional stakeholders to engage effectively in cohesion policy and access European financial instruments.

AIE focuses primarily on protection of the cultural heritage, protection of the environment, sustainable development in the fields of SMEs, tourism, fishery, transport and infrastructure. The support of the European citizenship also represents an important area of activity for the association, as well as the youth engagement and participation in EU life.

The AIE is governed by two main bodies, the General Assembly and the Executive Committee. They are responsible for the decision-making process of the association. The General Assembly is the highest authority of the organization, composed by all members, and is responsible for setting the political direction and strategic priorities. The Euroregion is headed by an elected President who serves as legal representative and manages the AIE in accordance with the Assembly's decisions. The AIE Secretariat is a team of professionals assisting the bodies of the Euroregion. The Secretariat facilitates communication among members and provides guidance and assistance in carrying out cooperative activities and projects.
