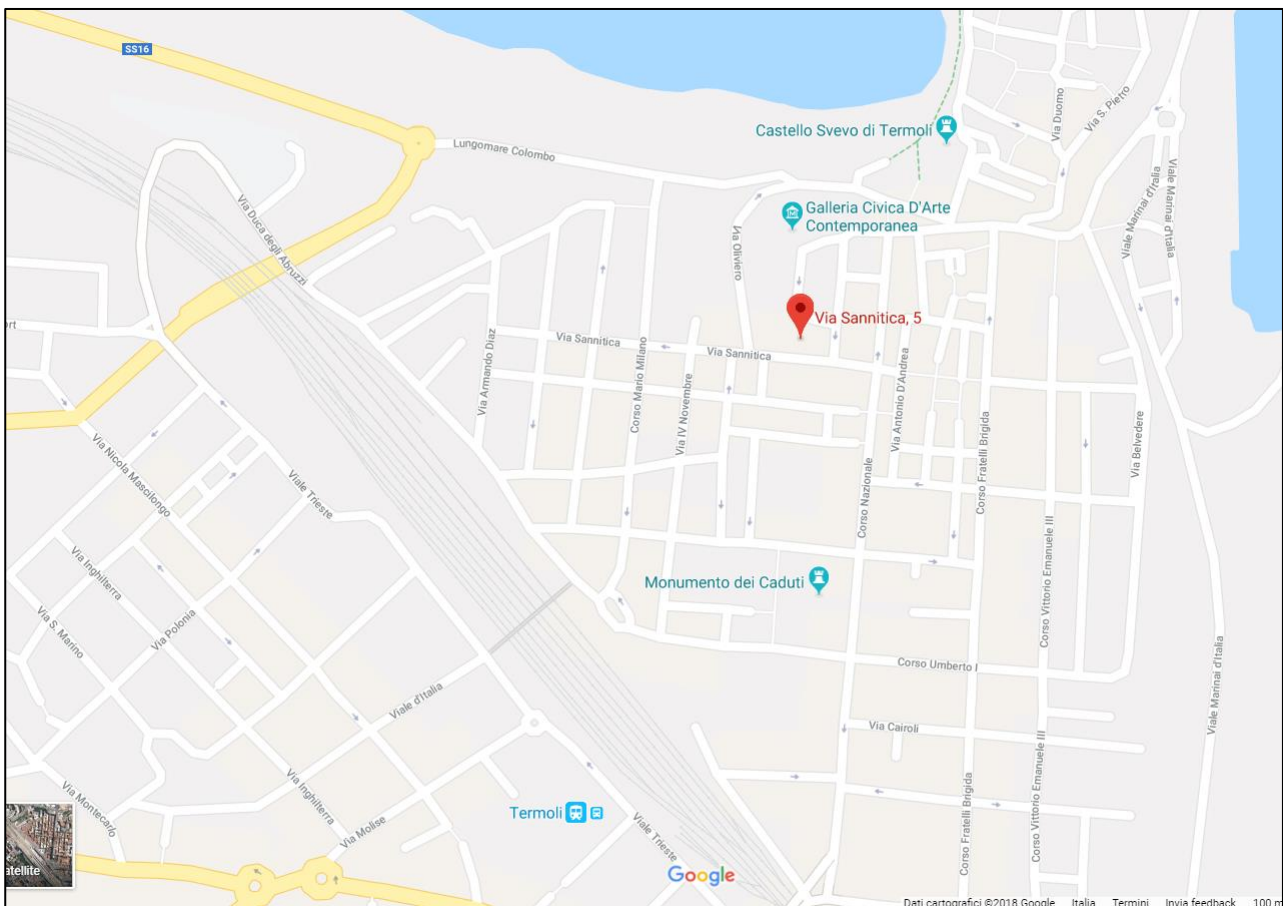

HOW TO GET TO TERMOLI?

Termoli is a municipality on the Adriatic coast of Italy, located in Molise Region (about 1 hour and a half from Pescara Airport and 3 and a half hours from Rome Airport).

By plane

The most convenient Airports to reach Termoli are the following:

The airport hubs with more flights are the two airports of Rome.

By train

The [Railway Station](#) is located in the city center. The station is crossed by the following lines:

- Bologna - Termoli
- Roma – Termoli (suggested track via Pescara Central Station)
- Pescara – Termoli
- Ancona – Termoli
- Bari – Termoli

The main destinations are: Pescara (Pescara Central Station), Rome (Roma Termini and Roma Tiburtina Stations), Ancona, Bari and Campobasso.

By bus

The [terminal bus station](#) is a 10-minute walk from the city center. The main destinations are:

- From and to Naples: Autolinee Cerella
- From and to Ancona, Firenze, Bologna, Milano, Torino: ATM, Ferrovie del Gargano
- From and to Campobasso: Sati

By Car

- From and to Bologna/Ancona/Pescara : Autostrada A14 - exit Termoli Molise
- From and to Bari : Autostrada A14 - exit Termoli Molise
- From and to Rome : Suggested track via Pescara : Autostrada A24 (Rome – Pescara) and Autostrada A14 - exit Termoli Molise
