AI-NURECC is a 18 months initiative of the key stakeholders of the Adriatic Ionian regions: the Conference of Peripheral Maritime Regions (CRPM), coordinator of the initiative, the Adriatic Ionian Euroregion (AIE), the Forum of Adriatic and Ionian Cities (FAIC), the Forum of the Adriatic and Ionian Chambers of Commerce (Forum AIC), and the Association of Universities of the Adriatic-Ionian area (UniAdrion).

Based on their long-lasting experience in topics fully in line with the thematic pillars of the European Union Strategy for the Adriatic and Ionian Region (EUSAIR), partners have decided to pool forces with the aim of supporting the implementation of the EUSAIR and its action plan, ensuring deep and spread territorial coverage, at regional and local level.

The Adriatic Ionian Euroregion is organising two events aimed at boosting discussion into the establishment of a framework for Adriatic-Ionian cross-cooperation in the youth field. The first event, the Info Day "Adriatic Ionian Youth own their Future" represents a first step towards a more structured and integrated dialogue between the EUSAIR institutional and technical structures and the Adriatic Ionian Youth. By raising awareness about Youth policies and related opportunities, the event is intended to facilitate youth participation in the creation, articulation and implementation of the EUSAIR. In this context, Youth Organisations and young people from the 8 EUSAIR countries are provided an outstanding opportunity to network and discuss their views about EUSAIR topics, and, more importantly, to share their perspectives with relevant decision-makers and stakeholders. The Info Day is also an occasion for presenting the second event, the "Adriatic Ionian Youth Organisations Forum", which will see Youth Organisations as protagonists of an innovative approach towards cooperation and territorial cohesion.

The two events will reinforce synergies between Adriatic Ionian local and regional, national and supranational actors, with the ultimate goal of fostering the capitalisation of EUSAIR macro-regional results.

Objectives:

- to provide a first networking occasion to AI Youth Organisations for exchanging experiences and discuss common challenges and solutions in a European perspective;
- to provide a setting for stimulating the dialogue between AI stakeholders as to how to effectively involve AI youth in the EUSAIR priorities and political agenda;
- to raise AI youth awareness of European policies, strategies and financial opportunities for youth cooperation in the Adriatic-Ionian area;
- to promote and pave the way to the AI Youth Organisations Forum and discuss a way of filling the existing gap among AI young generations and the EUSAIR institutional and technical structures.
